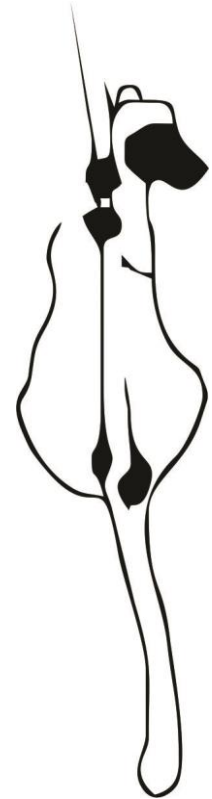

TRAINING

Introductory Workshops

Introductory level workshops contain theory and practical sessions on animal handling, husbandry, health and common diseases.

Topics Include:

- **Birds:** care and common health problems of captive and wild birds
- **Macropods** and other **Mammals:** care and common health problems of injured/orphaned or captive native species
- **Reptiles & Amphibians:** husbandry and common health problems seen in captivity
- **Bats:** care and common health problems, including human health risks
- **Wildlife:** basic triage, first aid and critical care for injured and orphaned wildlife

**No prior experience necessary.*

Advanced Workshops

Advanced level workshops develop a greater understanding of causes of common health problems, and discuss critical care management in greater detail.

Topics Include:

- **Birds:** critical care and health management of captive and wild birds
- **Macropods** and other **Mammals:** critical care and health management of marsupials and native mammals
- **Wildlife:** triage assessment, emergency first aid and critical care nursing for injured and orphaned wildlife

**Prior experience with the relevant species highly recommended.*
